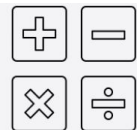


Term 2: Year 8 curriculum

Art: how can artists develop their drawings into three dimensional models?



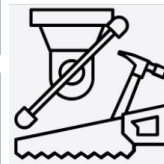
Drama: how can we devise a piece of physical theatre from a biography?
